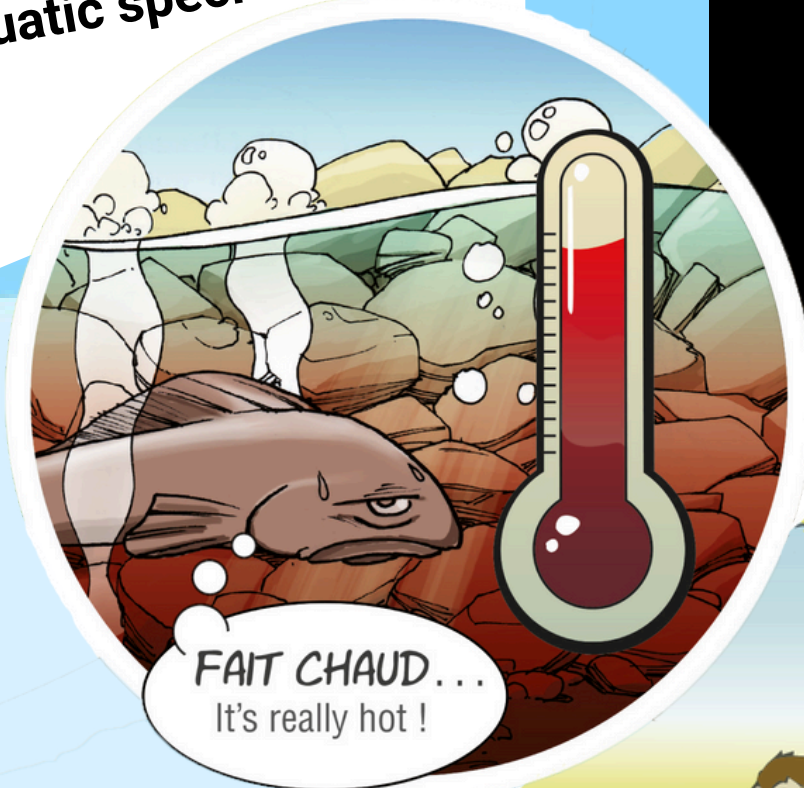


STOP AT THE PEBBLE DAMS



When the river's flow slows, the water heats up. Many aquatic species can't tolerate this.

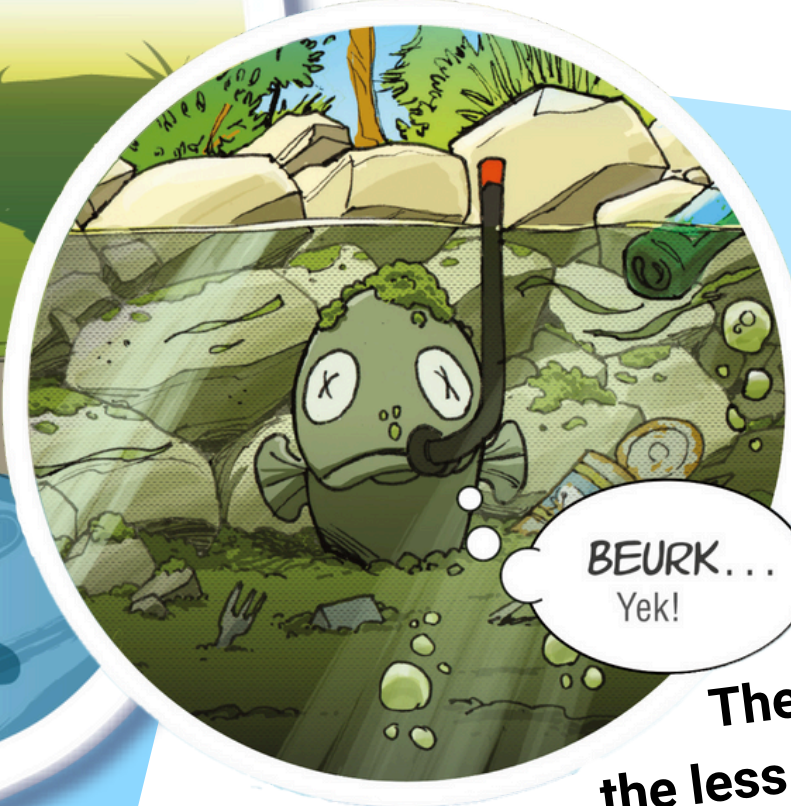


The formation of dams hinders fish movements.



Health risk caused by stagnation and warming, which promote the growth of bacteria.

Trampling and moving pebbles disrupts the habitat of fish and aquatic insects.



The warmer the water, the less oxygen it contains, which can contribute to asphyxiation of the environment.
